MOTION TO EXTEND TIME FOR ORDERING TRANSCRIPT

The Appellant respectfully moves this Honorable Court to allow four (4) additional days to order the transcript of the proceeding in this matter.

The Notice of Appeal was filed August 26, 2013. Rule 207 provides that the transcript of the proceeding be ordered from the court reporter within 10 days of the filing of the Notice of Appeal. This means that the transcript of proceeding was to be ordered by September 5, 2013. Counsel for the Plaintiff by mistake and inadvertence failed to order the transcript of the proceeding until September 9, 2013.

Counsel for the Appellant respectfully requests permission for four (4) additional days to order the transcript, and that the letter of September 9, 2013, to the court reporter be allowed to obtain the transcript of the proceeding.




