Based on the information contained in the notice of appeal, the above-referenced appeal appears to involve an appellate challenge to an order holding the appellant, Nathan Chambers, in criminal contempt. Under such circumstances, it is necessary for the South Carolina Attorney General's Office to represent the State as the respondent in this matter. See In re Martel, 444 S.C. 517, 520, 909 S.E.2d 402, 403 (2024) (explaining the State is the adverse party in an appeal of a criminal contempt conviction since criminal contempt is an offense against the State and instructing a person convicted of criminal contempt is required to serve the notice of appeal on the Attorney General). Accordingly, I respectfully ask this Court to please add me as counsel of record for the State as the respondent and forward all future correspondence regarding this matter directly to me.
