Please be advised that I am having serious problems with the delivery of my legal mail, as well as, personal mail here at the Kershaw Corr. Inst., for the past five months in particular and even prior to by one Mrs. Catherine Amason, Mrs. Amason has been intercepting, delaying, and destroying my mail under the banner of - "Office of General Counsel Terminate Correspondence or Postal Director / Staff Designee". Which has made it virtually impossible for me to comply with Court Orders or even receiving the Court orders and statements in a timely manner so that I can either correct or comply accordingly.

Your most recent letterhead dated and postmarked 2/12/25 concerning noted deficiencies was received by me today Feb. 20, 2025 through and by the head postmaster of SCDC Ms. K. Robinson. As you can see from the time gap of your mailing and my receipt thereof does suggest a delay in delivery. Moreover, had not Postal Service not visited Kershaw Corr. Inst. today (Ms. Robinson visits various Correctional facilities to ensure that the postal service is operating orderly and to correct any and all concerns dealing with Postal Service) I most likely wouldn't of received this very important order from your office. I have written to the SCDC Agency about the constant irregularities and violation of Agency policy GA. 06. 04 Sect. 2 by one Mrs. Catherine Amason and Mrs. M. Johnson here at the K. C. I. But, as you can see, the problem is preexisting. And I do not know either party nor have I had any verbal dispute with them. Which means that they're acting on behalf of someone whom my grievance is moving upon. Which is sad to say the least. Their professional moral is low and I can only leave their fate in God's hand. I am not the judge of any human-being.

Nonetheless, my other problem comes

in the form of requested payment. As the record does reflect, I am a prisoner housed in a state facility and do not earn hourly wages. Therefore, it is impossible for me to conform to that aspect of the SCRC. The mailroom has informed me that they don't have any forms to proceed without payment. So, I'm asking you if at all possible: Can the Court forward me two copies of such form and I will provide the mailroom with one so that they can make copies and have them available as needed? I also apologize for any inconvenience that I may have caused the Court. Also, I did send forth a copy of my Notice to Appeal the Order of Dismissal from the ALC to one Ms. Bigelow, Esq.
