**RESPONDENT SOUTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF EMPLOYMENT AND
WORKFORCE'S RESPONSE TO APPELLANT'S MOTION FOR
SUPPLEMENTAL RECORD**

On November 7, 2024, Appellant filed a Record on Appeal with this Court which did not include many of the items designated by Respondents for inclusion in the Record on Appeal. On December 10, 2024, Respondents filed a Motion to Dismiss asking this Court to dismiss Appellant's appeal or in the alternative to strike the Record filed by Appellant and Order her to file a new Record which complies with the rules and includes all matter designated by the parties. On December 20, 2024, Appellant filed a Return asking

this Court to permit her to correct the Record on Appeal. On January 31, 2025, this Court issued an Order striking the Record on Appeal filed by Appellant and ordering Appellant to “serve and file an amended record on appeal that complies with Rule 210(c), SCACR and includes all matters designated by Respondents, which were omitted from the previously filed record on appeal.” On February 19, 2025, Appellant filed a Motion for Supplemental Record, asking this Court to permit her to file a Supplemental Record rather than an Amended Record on Appeal as ordered by this Court.

Respondent South Carolina Department of Employment and Workforce would request that this Court deny Appellant’s Motion and reaffirm this Court’s prior Order requiring Appellant to file an Amended Record on Appeal that complies with Rule 210(c), SCACR and includes all matters designated by Respondents. This Court has already considered Appellant’s prior request to correct the Record and properly ruled that Appellant should be required to file a complete amended record instead. Aside from a statement of the prior costs of postage for filing the previously stricken record, Appellant has made no showing of financial hardship or explained why she should be relieved of the burden of filing a proper Amended Record on Appeal as directed by this Court’s January 31, 2025, Order. Respondent SCDEW asks that this Court deny Appellant’s Motion for Supplemental Record and order Appellant to file a proper Amended Record on Appeal as soon as possible to avoid further delay.


