In my case, Post-Conviction Hearing, the judge did not rule on every issue presented at my PCR and did not sufficiently rule on the issues he did address.

Allegation 1b. Failure to move to dismiss the armed Robbery - Plaintiff argues that at PCR the issue was that plea Counsel was to get the armed Robbery dropped not reduced to attempted armed Robbery. The court's ruling was insufficient because there was no evidence presented at PCR about attempted armed Robbery. In the facts given Rise to the Conviction in the Order of dismissal there was no armed Robbery and the judge insufficiently ruled on this case.

Allegation 1c. Failure to move to dismiss the three counts of attempted murder and he should have been charged with ABWK

Petitioner argues this issue was not raised at my PCR the issue was that trial Counsel was ineffective for not getting the attempted murder dropped because my co-defendant admitted he was the shooter and there was video evidence showing he was the shooter. (PCR Tr. pg. 33 L. 1-8) (PCR Tr. pg. 12 L. 1-4)

I have asked my PCR counsel to file for a Rule 69(c) and he has failed to address my issues.

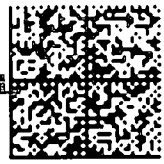
Also trial counsel told me to plea guilty and I would receive no more than 15 years. PCR Tr. pg. 11 L. 1-24
