In the interest of caution, I am contacting the court to ensure that it has received my **MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**, mailed on February 19, 2025.


Additionally, I humbly request guidance from the court to assure that I am in compliance with the Rules of the Court, due to me being a Pro se litigant.
