Defendant's Motion for the Entry of Satisfaction of Judgment was heard via WebEx on 1-27-25. After review, the motion is DENIED. The Plaintiff entered into a Covenant Not to Execute with Travelers Insurance which references no fewer than seven times the fact that the Covenant is meant to preserve Plaintiff's right to recover excess liability and/or UIM coverage. (See paragraphs 4, 5, 9, and numbered paragraphs 3, 5, 11, and 12). Satisfaction in violation of the clear terms and intent of the Covenant would result in an unfair windfall to Defendant that neither Travelers, Plaintiff, or Defendant intended when entering into the Covenant Not to Execute.
