Defendant's Motion for Relief from the August 9, 2023 Order of Judge Price was heard via WebEx on Jan. 27, 2025. After review, the Motion is DENIED. Defendant has failed to meet his burden of showing grounds under Rules 60(a) or 60(b), SCRPC, sufficient to vacate the order denying Defendant's Motion to Vacate Judge Culbertson's Order striking Defendant's Answer. The Order contains no clerical mistakes or ambiguities which would give rise to relief under Rule 60(a). Furthermore, Plaintiff has failed to show sufficient grounds for relief under Rule 60(b). Defendant's Answer was struck on June 1, 2022. Defendant's motion to vacate was not filed until Mar. 17, 2023. Judge Price denied the motion on Aug. 9, 2023, and the instant motion was not filed until May 31, 2024.
