
MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE APPELLANT 'S FINAL BRIEF



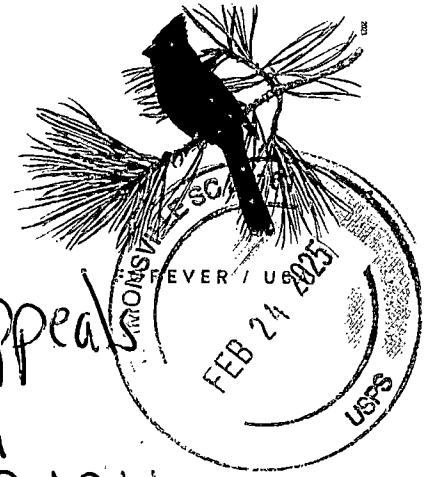
