I don't know who may be reading this kite, but I'm (Israel Robinson) asking that my case needs to be looked into. I was wrongfully convicted, and on top of that been over-sentenced. Once you've looked into my case, you'll see loop holes in my case. One thing I'll start by saying is I didn't pick nor have a say so in selecting my juror. Another is when my solicitor kept leading on witnesses. Even tho my witnesses (besides co-defendant) claim to have known me, and did not see me out there. I have been convicted

of Murder, Attempted Murder, and possession of a weapon during a violent crime.

I've sat in Charleston County since 7/1/21 all the way to when I got sentenced on 12/12/24. While I was sitting I studied hard into the law library, and noticed "in order to be convicted of Murder, the state has to prove beyond reasonable doubt". It also stated if the evidence presented only raises suspicion (sorry I ak how to spell) then the case has failed, and the defendant should be found not guilty. Evidence presented in trial was only circumstantial, and you can still be found guilty on circumstantial evidence I'll let you be judge on that. Only direct evidence I had was my

co-defendant statement claiming I was the shooter. He signed a deal stating that if cooperated, and complied he'd get 15-20 years, which was already obvious he'll say anything to get that 15-20. Witnesses have described him as he was seen on camera, so he was already known as the killer, which comes from the first and original statement of the Attempted Murder victim. Now my Attempted Murder victim didn't show up in court so his statement wasn't able to be used (at least that's what my lawyer told me), but yet I was still convicted on that anyways. It's alot more to the whole case, but I want to know that I'm being heard, and seen, and would like to speak to somebody ASAP regarding this whole situation. I know I was wrongfully convicted the proof is in the pudding itself.
