3. Current Financial Situation


- My family has struggled financially since my release.

- If necessary, we will find the means to pay, but any relief from immediate payment would be immensely helpful in allowing me to stabilize my financial situation.

REQUEST FOR RELIEF

- 1. Waive the required appellate fees for notice of appeal and this motion due to financial hardship; or**
- 2. Extend the deadline for payment of appellate fees to allow me time to regain financial stability.**
