I am writing in response to your September 2, 2009 letter. With the utmost respect in mind, I am requesting that you do not destroy the tapes in the above-named caption case which took place on or about November 3, 2008 before the Hon. Judge Larry Hyman. I am fully aware that you have already transcribed the second trial which was forwarded to the S.C. Commission of Indigent Defense.

Please find enclosed a motion that has been sent to the Courts in regards to payment arrangements because I am indigent. I ask respectfully that you preserve the trial tapes from destruction as I am aware that you can destroy after (5) years. However, S.C. Code of Law §14-13-10 and 14-13-20 mandates that these tapes "SHALL" be kept permanently. Rule 607 is in conflict with South Carolina Law.

Please do not destroy these tapes, as I am certain that the Courts will ORDER the payment by South Carolina Commission of Indigent Defense. A post conviction application is currently being prepared to filed with the Court. However, by time counsel is appointed the (5) year would have been expired. This requested transcript is crucial in proving my innocence. Sincerely, I am INNOCENT.

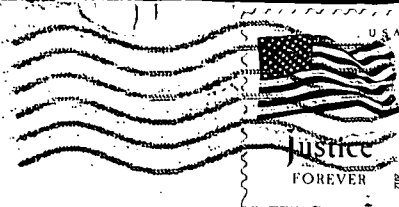
