ORDER

On February 10, 2025, Appellant filed an amended motion to stay her appeal and for expedited consideration of her amended motion. Appellant asked this court to stay her appeal while her petition for writ of certiorari remained pending in the South Carolina Supreme Court. No return was filed. The South Carolina Supreme Court denied Appellant's petition on January 14, 2025. After careful consideration, we grant Appellant's request for expedited consideration of her amended motion and deny Appellant's February 10, 2025 amended motion to stay as moot.

On February 11, 2025, Appellant filed a second amended motion to stay her appeal and for expedited consideration of her second amended motion. Appellant asked this court to stay her appeal while she seeks review by the United States Supreme Court. No return was filed. After careful consideration, we grant Appellant's request for expedited consideration of second amended motion and deny her February 11, 2025 second amended motion to stay her appeal.

Appellant must serve and file her initial brief and designation of matter within ten days of the date of this order. Failure to comply will result in dismissal of this appeal.¹
