Murder/Armed Robbery/Possession of a Weapon during the  
Commission of a Violent Crime

At a Court of General Sessions, convened on May 6, 2021 the Grand Jurors of  
SUMTER County present upon their oath:

**COUNT ONE-MURDER**

That Travon Derrell Ragin and Fre'Dron Kevan'Te Spann, did in Sumter County, on or about April 3, 2020, willfully, feloniously, and intentionally kill the victim, Sherrod Smith, with malice aforethought, either express or implied, by means of shooting the victim with a firearm, and the victim did die as a proximate result thereof in violation of Section 16-03-0010, S. C. Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.

**COUNT TWO-ARMED ROBBERY**

That on or about April 3, 2020, in Sumter County, South Carolina, the Defendants, Travon Derrell Ragin and Fre'Dron Kevan'Te Spann did at 1030 South Main Street, by use of force, threats or intimidation and while armed with a deadly weapon, or while alleging, either by action or words, he was armed while using a representation of a deadly weapon, did take and carry away goods and/or monies from the person or immediate presence of Sherrod Smith with the intent to permanently deprive the victim of possession thereof, in violation of Section 16-11-330(A) of the South Carolina Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.

**COUNT THREE-POSSESSION OF A WEAPON DURING A VIOLENT CRIME**

That Travon Derrell Ragin did in Sumter County, on or about April 3, 2020, possess a firearm, or visibly display what appeared to be a firearm, or visibly displayed a knife, during the commission or attempted commission of a violent crime, in violation of Section 16-23-0490, S. C. Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.
