## ORDER

On February 10, 2025, Appellant filed a notice of appeal challenging an order issued by the administrative law court concerning a disciplinary matter within the South Carolina Department of Corrections. According to the order, "Appellant was not sanctioned any accrued good time." On February 27, 2025, Appellant filed a motion to proceed *in forma pauperis*. After careful consideration, we deny his request to proceed *in forma pauperis*. See *Ex parte Martin*, 321 S.C. 533, 535, 471 S.E.2d 134, 134-35 (1995) ("Motions to proceed *in forma pauperis* may be granted only when authorized by statute or required by constitutional provisions."); *Howard v. S.C. Dep't of Corr.*, 399 S.C. 618, 629, 733 S.E.2d 211, 217 (2012) ("[A]n inmate does not acquire an interest in sentence-related credits until he or she earns them."). The filing fee must be paid within thirty days of the date of this order. Failure to provide the filing fee will result in dismissal of the appeal.
