Hi Morgan, I hope that all is well. I received your information from Kevin Smith, after we spoke on Friday 2/28/25, I called Eagleview 3430 East and spoke to Keyana Johnson who identified herself as the Property Manager. I asked her if she could provide two documents (W-9 and Vendor Classification Form) which are required by Goodwill Industries in order for us to issue a paper check which is required by the court. Ms. Johnson informed me that she had to get permission to give me the requested information.

On Monday 3/3/25 at 9:12am, I sent a follow-up email to Ms. Johnson to inquire about an update concerning the requested paperwork and I still haven't received a response.

On Tuesday 3/4/2025, I called the apartment complex twice around 5:00pm and there was no answer.

Today 3/5/2025, I called the apartment complex and I spoke with Stephanie who identified herself as the Regional Manager, she told me that Keyana did send the paperwork to the corporate office and they are waiting on a response. She said that they have to have permission to share the information with new organization that are attempting to assist the residents.

So as of today, I have not been able to acquire the needed information to provide assistance for Mr. Smith. The Finance Department from Goodwill was willing to produce the check in one day for Mr. Smith but we have not be able to get the information that's needed. Normally this process can take up to one month. We understand the severity on Mr. Smiths situation and we've done everything within our power to assist him but we've been met with some resistance from Eagleview.
