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MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION TO SERVE AND FILE  
THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI  
AND APPENDIX

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Counsel for William Anthony Wallace respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, from March 14, 2025 until April 14, 2025**, in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for William Anthony Wallace respectfully submits that extraordinary

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circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. Counsel will file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Gregory Benjamin with the Court of Appeals on Monday, March 17, 2025. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Justin Cole Carroll with the Court of Appeals on March 7, 2025. Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of The State v. Devin Jamel Johnson with the Court of Appeals on March 6, 2025. Counsel was an appellate panel member at the annual Criminal Law CLE sponsored by the South Carolina Bar on Friday, February 28, 2025 in Columbia. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Craig Lee Legette with the Court of Appeals on Wednesday, February 5, 2025. Counsel, with co-counsel Lara M. Caudy, filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of The State v. Bowen Gray Turner with the Court of Appeals on January 23, 2025. Counsel, with co-counsel Lara M. Caudy, filed the Return to Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of The State v. Kierin Marcellus Dennis with this Court on Friday, January 17, 2025. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Kenneth Lewis with the Court of Appeals on January 13, 2025. **Counsel also has extensive administrative duties as the Chief Appellate Defender, including attempting to hire two new Appellate Defenders, and an administrative assistant, while carrying a full caseload.**


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. On March 3, 2025, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously

consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through March 31, 2025.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a **final thirty (30) day extension from March 14, 2025 until April 14, 2025**, in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances. Counsel requests that time limits for filing the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.
