CONSIDER BY REHEARING OR
IN ALTERNATIVE REINSTATE-
MENT IN THE INTEREST OF
JUSTICE & A PROTECTION ORDER

Both orders dated January 17, 2025, received February 6, 2025 After
Medical EMERGENCY - Extraordinary Circumstances Alert

Factual Background

At the first opportunity, the second week of Feb. Appellant managed to reach retained Law Firm, the Bell Legal Group ("BLG") personnel updating the status of change of mailing address to Lee Institution, 990 Wisacky Hwy. Bishopville, SC 29010 after another emergency.

Upon previous specific notification to this appeals court and other courts, etc. seeking a 'protection order' December 2024 and previously because of worsening ongoing life threatening events. Most recently earlier in January, amazonly Appellant managed to get aid through an inmate to locate the one SCDC guard, Ms. Tamron, assigned to two living units.

After delay, Appellant was wheelchaired by two other inmates to "Evans Medical", one SCDC Nurse. After more delay, in ambulance transported to the Critical Care Unit ("CCU") for two weeks at the Regional Florence Mcleod Hospital. From the hospital, Appellant was re-assigned by Evans Institution Warden Donnie Stonebreaker and Company to the notorious LEE IN-stitution.

In addition to the pre-Jan. ~~to~~ hospital admittance, seven cardiac and other essential medications proscribed by MUSC Health March 2024, previously specifically brought to this appeals court seeking a protection order due to Appellant's life threatening declining health.

The Florence Regional Mcleod Health Care Team proscribed a thirty (30) day supply of (generic through SCDC) enoxaparin injections twice a day in the Stomach, daily warfarin and weekly blood lab draws for careful

"Pt and INR" testing ranges between 2.0 - 3.0. Appellant's test of 1/7/6 was the last McLeod blood lab extraction before premature discharge at SCDC, etc. pattern efforts.

Fluticasone Propionate & salmeterol powder Inhaler was added Feb. 13, 2025 with already proscribed Albuterol sulfate inhaler.

On Feb. 6. Appellant received two orders "filed Jan. 17, 2025". One, a two part order in two separate consolidated civil actions.

Legal photocopies were not made accessible until Feb. 24 and March 2025.

See "Supporting Factual General Documentation Index" and enclosed credible evidence. Specifically, in factual light of Appellant's previous request from the Courts for protective orders 3 & 4 months prior for serious worsening health conditions, . . . and now regarding the CCU McLeod two weeks hospitalization then re-assignment² from the hospital to Lee Institution, a protective order to reasonably respond, a Judicial and independent investigation is warranted to regain Public trust. For equal Justice and equal Justice alone.

Updating, upon information and belief, more criminal acts have willfully occurred regarding ongoing interference and obstruction of Appellant-Plaintiff sending and untimely receiving mailings to and from the Courts

Also of significance, the appeals Court should not ignore or overlook Appellant's Four SCRCF, Rule 59(e) motions marked and filed to each formal circuit court adverse judgments within these three civil actions.

By credible truth, with good faith in the interest of Justice. once again Appellant & Associates seek to preserve the integrity of our uniform legal profession, to detect and prevent further pollution in the lower court to equally and justly officially address now the credible Public evidence, . . . we ask this appeals Court to refer, recommend or order an investigation by the proper authorities or Judicial oversight committee to take necessary action to hold involved persons accountable. Clear fraud upon the Courts exist. Mail tampering and willful interference. Having the opportunity again, if the Appeals Court will now unbiasedly ethically review the Five Circuit Court written orders involving 3 State Judges and the official public hearing transcripts. We plead this Appellate Court act now

to protect, defend and preserve the integrity of the South Carolina Courts and gain Public trust, To show equality and Justice for all people. As our United States and state Constitutions Democratically Declares.

THEREFORE, based on these particular points of facts, Appellant timely mailed Notice of Appeals with Proof of Services in both Appellate cases, now encloses proof of services, timely responded to each of the lower courts four orders by SCRPC, Rule 59(e), the lengthy history of prejudicial mail tampering, interference and corruption among SCDC involved employees with third parties to thwart/injure incarcerated persons exercising lawful rights, namely this Appellant, as meticulously archived.

Independent defense counsel's pattern of unprofessional improprieties, pollution of the legal profession and other caught in the act wrongdoing with third parties,

The prior fact and now prayer for a rational, timely protective order grounded on empirical evidence - scientific MUSC Health, McLeod Hospital and other extensive Medical Records, nine presently proscribed medications for Appellants **daily life threatening** cardiac diagnosis, numerous pulmonary embolisms (blood clots in lungs) etc. A direct contributing factor of defendant SCDC and its involved employees etc. for intentionally denying and patternly delaying Appellant two years from standard examination by a Cardiologist until March 2024 and a Pulmonologist until August 2024 based on his worsed consistently complained of symptoms and request for specialty necessary health care independent of SCDC.

Note, admissions and other specifically recorded credible evidence past and present directly involved Evans Institution employees admit culpability and/or blame co-workers. Another piece to the corruption puzzle.


These foregoing facts should compel the court leave as Appellant shows good cause to justly grant this collective motion according to Rule 31(a), SCACR.

Foot Note Section

Foot Note 1: America's second largest riot occurred April 2018 at Lee Institution. The first 3 weeks in Feb. 2025 Appellant personally observed 3 inmate "cutters" harming themselves, possible suicides that inmate medical responders arrived in the living unit with a bed on wheels attending to life threatening wounds (neck, stomach, wrist/arm) until 3 ambulances ultimately arrived. Two prisoners "wiggling out" on synthetic controlled substances. One actual suicide by hanging and one person overdosed. Severe SCDC Lee Institution Staffing Shortage. Previously professionally supported by Expert Witness Tom Roth, the "Roth Report", other experts, compiled data, statistics and facts.

Foot Note 2: On Jan. 23, 2025 while in the McLeod Hospital on Jan. 29th Appellant first discovered all his personal property equipment, except his lamp were "missing" suspiciously per Ms. Jackson, Lee Inst.'s Property Post person while under the custody and control of SCDC, etc. see Attachment A, Evans Institution Property Inventory sheet. ATTM.B, Lee Inst.'s Property Inventory Form Appellant signed with prejudice under great duress and coercion. ATTM.C, April 2021 Evans Inst. misleading "annual" inventory sheet. Appellant's most recent inventory showing items purchased while employed through Prison Industries at Midcon Cables. Fact, the six years Appellant assigned to Evans Institution only two inventories occurred on his watch. For many years, zero living units, resident rooms, etc. inspections, and numerous other neglected systemic failures, all clear breaches of applicable SCDC policies, state and federal law.
