Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this matter will be dismissed:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. You must include the name and address of the party served.
- The notice of appeal is not accompanied by a copy of the post-trial motion challenged on appeal.
- You must provide an amended notice of appeal which includes the date written notice of the order on the post-trial motion was received.
- You must include provide proof that the notice of appeal was filed with the Lexington County Clerk of Court.
