

**MOTION TO ASSOCIATE
THE OFFICE OF INDIGENT DEFENSE
FOR COSTS**

COMES NOW the Appellant, by and through the undersigned counsel, and moves to have the South Carolina Commission on Indigent Defense (SCCID) associated to cover the costs of the appeal. Appellant was charged in Union County with Murder and Possession of a Weapon During the Commission of a Violent Crime. Undersigned counsel was retained for the trial wherein Appellant was convicted of Voluntary Manslaughter and Possession of the Weapon. The Honorable R. Keith Kelly sentenced Appellant to an aggregate sentence of 35 years. Appellant requested, and Undersigned Counsel has agreed to represent Appellant in his appeal *pro bono*. 



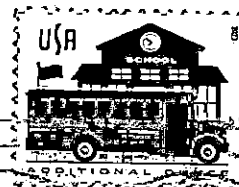
