MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO

Counsel for appellant respectfully requests a **fourth and final thirty (30) day extension from March 24, 2025, until April 23, 2025**, in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the above-referenced case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for appellant respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions

previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel filed the Anders Brief of Appellant and Record on Appeal in the case of The State v. Ryan Gist with the Court of Appeals on March 5, 2025. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying Appendix in the case of Matthew Pickens v. The State with the Court of Appeals on February 18, 2025. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying Appendix in the case of Daeshaun Forrest v. The State with the Supreme Court on February 7, 2025. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Rico Funderburk with the Court of Appeals on February 7, 2025. Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of Holly Thompson v. State with the Court of Appeals on February 5, 2025. Counsel filed the reply to the return to the petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Billy Geisendorff v. State with the Supreme Court on February 6, 2025. Counsel filed the initial reply brief of appellant in the case of The State v. Kyle Mouzon with the Court of Appeals on January 16, 2025.

4. On March 3, 2025, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through March 31, 2025.




