

I received a letter from Attorney Allison Carter, Esquire, on Friday, October 4, 2013, where she is submitting a Motion to dismiss my Appeal. I am hereby submitting a Motion to reject this Motion of Dismissal. There has not been any change in my right shoulder and other injuries that I sustained in the January 1995 fall and the Worker's Compensation hearing that was held in December of 1997 where decisions were already made concerning my right shoulder by a prior worker's Compensation Commissioner. There has not been any change in my right shoulder since Commission Mickle gave me an Order that I could bring up the claim for the injury to my right shoulder whenever I wanted to.
