**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE WRIT OF CERTIORARI
AND APPENDIX**

Pursuant to Rule 240, SCACR, petitioner Ronnie L. Legg moves for an extension of time in which to serve and file petitioner's Writ of Certiorari to be included in the Record on Appeal. Petitioner requests an extension of thirty (30) days to file the Writ of Certiorari and Appendix which are currently due March 31, 2025. This is the second extension request filed by Petitioner.

The grounds for this motion are that other impending professional matters and obligations have created a need for additional time to prepare the Writ of Certiorari and Appendix. Specifically, counsel for Petitioner has had a sentencing in the case of *United States v. Appiah* and had two sentencing deadlines in the case of *United States v. Walker*, another pending appellate deadline in the S.C. Court of Appeals for *State v. McKnight*, and numerous lower court appearances requiring travel all over the state. A thirty-day delay will not prejudice the rights of any of the parties. Granting this motion would require the Writ of Certiorari and Appendix to be filed with the Court no later than April 30, 2025.

For these reasons, Petitioner requests an extension of the deadline for filing and serving the Writ of Certiorari and Appendix until April 30, 2025.
