**ORDER DENYING MOTION TO
RECONSIDER APPOINTMENT OF
RECEIVER**

THIS MATTER came before the Court on September 5, 2013 upon a Notice of Motion to Reconsider Appointment of Receiver Pursuant To Rule 66 of the South Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure by Defendant Interfaith Apts. Co. Appearing for the Plaintiff was S. Nelson Weston, Jr., Esquire of Richardson, Plowden & Robinson, P.A. and Ian Ford on behalf of Defendant Interfaith Apts. Co., a S.C.L.P, a South Carolina limited partnership.

The Court ordered the appointment of a Receiver on May 1, 2013. On May 10, 2013, Defendant Interfaith Apts. Co. filed its Motion for Reconsideration of the Appointment of Receiver with the Williamsburg County Court of Common Pleas, which is the basis of this Order.

The evidence before the Court shows grounds were established by the Plaintiff for the appointment of the receiver and therefore the motion of the Defendant to reconsider is denied.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT the Defendant's Motion for Reconsideration be denied.
