## ORDER

On January 23, 2025, Appellant filed a "Notice of Request for the Order to Bring About the Correction of All Attorney Errors and Procedural Deficiencies to be Included in the Record on Appeal." Respondent filed a return, opposing the relief requested. On February 3, 2025, Appellant filed a "Motion to Bring About the Correction of the Record and the Recusal of the Judge and the Inclusion of the Trustee as the Indispensable Party." Respondent filed a return, opposing the relief requested. After careful consideration, we deny Appellant's motions.

On March 13, 2025, Appellant filed a "Submission of Judicial Notice of Non-Participation & Withdrawal – Secured Party Standing," which we construe as a motion, seeking to substitute Appellant with the Keiven Keon Minter Trust. Respondent filed a return, objecting to the requested relief. After careful consideration, we deny Appellant's motion to substitute. *See* S.C. Code Ann. § 40-5-310 (2011) ("No person may either practice law or solicit the legal cause of another person or entity in this State unless he is enrolled as a member of the South Carolina Bar pursuant to applicable court rules, or otherwise authorized to perform prescribed legal activities by action of the Supreme Court of South Carolina.").
