This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed today.

2. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of Mitchell Rivers v. State in the Supreme Court on April 2, 2025. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Calvin Ford with the Court of Appeals on March 20, 2025. Counsel

filed the Johnson Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Bryant McKnight v. The State with the Supreme Court on March 7, 2025. Counsel filed the Anders Brief of Appellant and Record on Appeal in the case of The State v. Ryan Gist with the Court of Appeals on March 5, 2025. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying Appendix in the case of Matthew Pickens v. The State with the Court of Appeals on February 18, 2025. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying Appendix in the case of Daeshaun Forrest v. The State with the Supreme Court on February 7, 2025. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Rico Funderburk with the Court of Appeals on February 7, 2025. Counsel filed the reply to the return to the petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Billy Geisendorff v. State with the Supreme Court on February 6, 2025. Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of Holly Thompson v. State with the Court of Appeals on February 5, 2025.




