MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO

Counsel for Petitioner respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Petitioner respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions

previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Casey Fickling v. The State with the Supreme Court on March 4, 2025. Counsel filed the Anders Brief of Appellant and Record on Appeal in the case of The State v. Arkevus Jimon Cauthen with the Court of Appeals on February 20, 2025. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Dimitri T. Dickens with the Court of Appeals on February 14, 2025. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Aaron Williams v. The State with the Supreme Court on January 29, 2025. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Nazareth Sanchez-Peralta with the Court of Appeals on January 3, 2025.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. On March 28, 2025, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through April 30, 2025.


