

ORDER

On February 19, 2025, Respondent filed a motion to substitute counsel and to dismiss the appeal, arguing this court lacks appellate jurisdiction because Appellant failed to file a motion for reconsideration with the Administrative Law Court as required by South Carolina Administrative Law Court Rules. Appellant filed a return, opposing the motion to dismiss; Respondent did not file a reply. After careful consideration, we grant Respondent's motion to substitute counsel but deny Respondent's motion to dismiss without prejudice to the parties filing supplemental memoranda within thirty days of the date of this order addressing appellate jurisdiction. *See* SCALC Rule 29(D)(4) and 40(B). This court will consider the supplemental memoranda at the same time it considers the appeal.
