## ORDER

Appellant filed a record on appeal on November 7, 2024, which was served on Respondents on November 21, 2024. On December 10, 2024, Respondents filed a motion to dismiss, arguing the record on appeal was not in compliance with Rule 210(c) of the Appellate Court Rules because it did not include all matters designated by Respondent. Appellant filed a return, asking for an opportunity to correct the record on appeal. No reply was filed. On January 31, 2025, this court denied Respondent's motion to dismiss but struck the record on appeal. This court ordered Appellate to serve and file an amended record on appeal that complied with Rule 210(c), SCACR and included all matters designated by Respondents, which were omitted from the previously filed record on appeal within thirty days of the date of that order.

On February 19, 2025, Appellant moved to file a supplemental record on appeal that contains the matters omitted from the first record on appeal. Respondent South Carolina Department of Employment and Workforce filed a return opposing the motion. No other returns were received and Appellant did not file a reply. After careful consideration, Appellant's motion to file a supplemental record is denied. Within twenty days of the date of this order Appellant shall serve and file an amended record on appeal or this appeal will be dismissed.
