This case involves a probation violation which occurred on 1/2/10
at the time I was in the ICU unit at Grand Strand Medical Center
on a severe infection from December 9th through December
17th and even spoke to my PO Marlow from my room
after getting out of the Hospital my cell phone was
stolen from me and I gave him a # that I could be
reached at 24/7... The next time I saw him was
1/30/25 where I was arrested for a FTA at my hearing
on a bench warrant pending trial on 3/3/25. This was my
1st offense and the Judge said he was giving me 10 Yrs
for willfully violating my probation for a charge I
~~had~~ had served 27 months on before starting probation
I had ASKED for a public defender by filling out the
paperwork on 1/31/25 at JRLDC in Conway S.C.
BUT I never received a attorney leaving me to feel
like I had to represent myself in my defense.
Clearly I was unable to defend myself and the Judge
in the case gave me the maximum sentence.

Consequently I'm asking for a new trial in this Matter where I am granted a Attorney was guaranteed under my Constitutional Rights or a reversal of this verdict.

I am able to prove my whereabouts during the 4mes and this is the standard for cruel and Unusual punishment.

At my age 67 it is almost a life sentence for being sick.

I'm running out of options Ma'am and ask that I be shown mercy in this Matter and I'm not a threat to anyone.
