Dear Mr. Mills:

Upon reviewing your attempted deficiency corrections, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this matter will be dismissed:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. Specifically, you stated that you served January Taylor, Esquire. You must provide the address at which she was served as well as the correct date of service.
- Your notice of appeal states you are attempting to appeal an order dated January 28, 2025. A review of the public index does not indicate that there is a January 28, 2025 Order. You must either provide the January 28, 2025 order, or if you are attempting to appeal the February 28, 2025 order, you must provide an amended notice of appeal and a copy of that order.
- You must provide proof of filing this notice of appeal with the Richland County Clerk of Court.
