

We received your notice of appeal dated April 10, 2025. It appears you are attempting to appeal from an action by the magistrate's court. If you wish to appeal an action by the magistrate's court, you must file your notice of appeal in the Dorchester County Court of Common Pleas. If you wish to appeal a decision by the Court of Common Pleas, you must serve and file a notice of appeal that identifies the order from which an appeal is taken, including a copy of the order on appeal, and provide the date you received written notice of entry of the order or judgement on appeal. See Rule 203, SCACR. If you wish to amend your notice of appeal to include reference to an appealable order from the Court of Common Pleas, you must file a motion to amend the notice of appeal within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal may be dismissed.
