DEFENDANT'S MOTION TO COMPEL PRODUCTION OF DOCUMENTS AND  
INSTRUMENTS

(Pursuant to Rule 34 of the State Rules of Civil/Criminal Procedure)

COME NOW the living man, Newitt Rodney Walker, appearing specially and without granting general jurisdiction, as the Principal and Holder in Due Course, over the legal estate NEWITT RODNEY WALKER, and pursuant to lawful procedure, moves the court to order plaintiff to produce and disclose the following documents for inspection and copying within (30) days of service, pursuant to Rule 34 of civil/criminal procedure. This motion is based on the need for full disclosure, the right to face the source of any claim, and the requirement that all commercial interests and bonding instruments related to the NAME and proceeding are made available to the real party in interest.

DOCUMENTS TO BE PRODUCE

1. Any and all performance bonds, appearance bonds, surety bonds, bid bonds, or payment bonds issued in this matter or related to the NAME "NEWITT RODNEY WALKER".
2. The original application, Certificate of registration, and trading account information, for any CUSIP, DTCC, or any Treasury instrument created or assigned to this case.

3. Copies of any contracts or agreements bearing wet-ink signature of the living man, Newitt Rodney Walker which bind him to statutory jurisdiction or authorize the use of the NAME in commercial or administrative proceedings.

4. Identify any contracts bearing wet-ink signature of the living man Newitt Rodney Walker that authorize this proceeding, bind him to the statutory obligations or appoint you as fiduciary or trustee.

5. State the full legal and financial interest your agency or office has in this matter, and whether such interest is bonded, secured, or pledged to a third party.

6. Identify the statute, law, or commercial code under which you assert jurisdiction over the living man, and state whether such jurisdiction is based on contract, assumption, or implied consent.

7. Identify any commercial paper, lien, or bill of exchange that has been created, traded, bonded, and deposited in relation to this proceeding.

8. State whether any of the instruments tied to this case, or the NAME have been monetized, pledged, or hypothecated through the Courts Registry Investment System (CRIS,) Treasury Direct, DTCC, or any related system.

9. Identify the name, address, and financial institution, or clearing house where any trust account, bond instrument or deposit related to this case is held.

10. Identify all parties who are acting as trustees, fiduciaries, bond underwriters, or third-party beneficiaries of the legal estate "NEWITT RODNEY WALKER" within this case or any other related financial activity.

11. Address and rebut all points of affidavit of specific negative averments that's on the record.

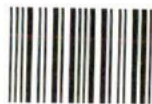
