We are in receipt of the Court's letter from April 10, 2025, regarding issues with the recordings contained on State's Exhibit # 22 in the above-referenced criminal appeal. With the consent of counsel for the appellant, we are providing the Court with a disc containing a digital file of a screen recording of the contents of the relevant jail call—the January 16, 2018, call that was placed at approximately 9:31 p.m.—played from State's Exhibit # 22 during the appellant's trial. The digital file reflects that particular jail call recording being played directly from the Charleston County Detention Center's proprietary software that is contained on State's Exhibit # 22. Before submitting the digital file to this Court, our office confirmed through the solicitor who prosecuted the appellant's case the January 16, 2018, jail call recording was the only portion of State's Exhibit # 22 that was played for the jury during the appellant's trial, and consistent information appears on page 437 of the Record on Appeal.
