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## ORDER

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On April 9, 2013, Appellants served and filed a notice of appeal from the master in equity's order of February 13, 2013. Appellants contend they "never received written notice" of the order. Respondent subsequently filed a motion to dismiss this appeal, arguing the notice of appeal was untimely served because Appellants received written notice of the order on February 22, 2013. Respondents attached a letter dated February 22, 2013, indicating Respondents mailed, faxed, and emailed the underlying order to Appellants on February 22, 2013. Appellant did not file a return.

After careful consideration, this appeal is dismissed. *See* Rule 203(b)(1), SCACR ("A notice of appeal shall be served on all respondents within thirty (30) days after receipt of written notice of entry of the order or judgment."); Rule 263(b), SCACR ("The time prescribed by these Rules for performing any act except the time for serving the notice of appeal under Rule[] 203 . . . may be extended or shortened by the appellate court . . ."). The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b), SCACR.
