I have received a document from the court of appeals regarding the court date that was set for March 17, 2025 and attached it to this email. The attached documents states that I have to submit a prodocued orders by Friday April 25th. I contacted the circuit court to get further details on this document. I was told by the clerk that both parties had to provide a email or writin doucmnt stating why the judge should make a decision on either party. From my understanding on Feb 24 the court of appeals provided a document reinstating my appeal as well as an expedited hearing on the motion to stay and determination of appeal. On March 17th that did not take place during the hearing. The judge needed more time to review the documents. Also, I have been able to obtain transcripts from the circuit court for the case that's being apealed which is 2024CV0210700265 which is where the judge decided to rule on behalf of the plaintiff. The only problem is we also had a case (2024CV0210700276) which was for a summons of complaints for the "back rent" that the plaintiffs stated I owed during the rule of vacate case. The judge of the migrate court ruled in my favor over the plaintiffs stating that I had in fact overpaid the plaintiff. Due to the fact that I had already filed an appeal for the case 2024CV0210700265 she could not propose the Rule 60. I have tried very hard to get the transcript of the summons and complaints. The migrate court stated they earse the transcripts and audio after 90 days and the circuit court stated they can not provide because it wouldn't be associated with the appeal. The whole purpose of the appeal is because I wanted to prove that I did not owe anything as far as back rent. The summons and complaints proves this whole theory. I hope you take into consideration all of the information that I have provided here today.
