



## ORDER

On February 25, 2025, this court dismissed this appeal because Appellant failed to provide a corrected notice of appeal, statement of when he received written notice of entry of the order under appeal, proof of service for the notice of appeal, proof of filing a copy of the notice of appeal with the lower court, and the notice of appeal filing fee. On February 28, 2025, March 3, 2025, March 5, 2025, and March 6, 2025, Appellant sent letters to this court, arguing he was not required to pay a filing fee and was otherwise not required to comply with the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules due to his incarceration. We construe these letters as a petition to rehear our order of dismissal. After careful consideration of the petition for rehearing, the court is unable to discover that any material fact or principle of law has been either overlooked or disregarded, and hence, there is no basis for granting a rehearing.
