

ORDER

On December 11, 2024, Appellant filed a motion to stay the circuit court's order dismissing her appeal of a magistrate's writ of ejectment. Also, on December 11, 2024, this court issued an order continuing the temporary stay until additional information could be obtained by the parties and provided to this court. On March 17, 2024, Respondent provided this court with a copy of the transcript of the August 16, 2024 hearing before the circuit court on Appellant's motion to stay. Respondent did not file a return to Appellant's motion to stay. After careful consideration, we grant the motion to stay and order Appellant to comply with the circuit court's October 31, 2024 order requiring her to pay the bond of \$700 on the first of every month and no later than the sixth day of every month.¹

¹ We note that during the August 16 hearing, the circuit court provided conflicting information regarding the due date for the monthly bond payment. Although the circuit court stated several times that due to the statutory five-day grace period the bond must be paid by the fifth day of the month, the circuit court also stated that if Appellant did not pay by the sixth day of the month, then she would be evicted.
