MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI
AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Joshua W. Porch respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days from May 1, 2025 until June 2, 2025 in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Joshua W. Porch respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



On April 28, 2025, counsel filed the brief of respondent in the Matter of Andy Hyman with the Supreme Court. On April 28, 2025, counsel filed the brief of respondent in the Matter of Shawn Daily with the Supreme Court. On April 25, 2025, counsel, along with co-counsel, filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in The State v. Bowen Turner with the Supreme Court. On April 24, 2025, counsel filed the return to the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in Carrol Washington v. The State with the Supreme Court. On April 17, 2025, counsel filed the brief of respondent in Gabriel Rios v. The State with the Court of Appeals. On April 15, 2025, counsel filed the brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. Braelon Brown with the Court of Appeals. On April 4, 2025, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. Kemontee Blocker with the Court of Appeals.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


