Good Afternoon Court of Appeals Staff,

I have attached a signed copy of my Proof Of Service and a signed copy of my Notice of Appeal. My apologies for that error. I have also attached a screenshot of the filing in Magistrate court and the court of common pleas that this case was and still is a criminal case. I was given 2 tickets from a sheriff deputy in Newberry SC on January 10 2024 for Animal Bite & Inoculation.

Me and my dog were found not guilty for the animal bite by a jury trial. I was found guilty (by default) on the inoculation charge and somehow was made to pay restitution fees all related to the Animal Bite charge. Which is why I have appealed. The Inoculation/Restitution was directly related to the accusation of a dog bite.

DHEC staff, Newberry County Animal Control Staff and the Police Officer testified, Body Camera footage was reviewed by the jury, judge and courtroom attendees and the verdict was Not Guilty because there never was a dog bite, but yet I was still penalized for a Dog Bite.

I am asking the court to please review this case to confirm that it does fall under Criminal and Not Civil. The police issued the ticket which could have resulted in jail time.
