PRISONER STATUS

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE the undersigned moves on October 4, 2013 before this Court for and Order granting him in forma pauperis in this appeal on the ground(s): Martin v. State, 471 S.E.2d 134, 135 (1995)[The Court stressed, "Further, where certain fundamental rights are involved, the Constitution requires that an indigent be allowed access to the Courts."] Appellant was granted leave to proceed in the Administrative Law Court to proceed in forma pauperis in the appeal of disciplinary grievance. Howard v. South Carolina Department of Corrections, 733 S.E.2d 211 (2012); the 9-9-13 shows, he "received sanctions that included loss of sixty (60) days of accrued good-time." (p. 1 of 3).
