**ORDER DENYING MOTION
TO RECONSIDER OR MODIFY SENTENCE**

Defendant filed a Motion to Reconsider Sentence on February 27, 2025. Defendant was found guilty by jury verdict on October 31, 2024 of two (2) indictments of Attempted Murder and nine (9) indictments of Assault and Battery of a High and Aggravated Nature (ABHAN). Sentencing was deferred until February 21, 2025. This Court sentenced Defendant to a concurrent twenty (20) years for 8 convictions of ABHAN, twenty -five (25) years concurrent for two (2) convictions of Attempted Murder, and fifteen (15) years for the remaining ABHAN conviction to be served consecutive to the another ABHAN conviction. The total sentence amounted to thirty-five (35) years in the prison.

This court has reconsidered this sentence after now having completed all three cases for each defendant involved in the April 16, 2022 Columbiana Mall shootings. In light of all the facts and circumstances, the victim statements and the mitigation presented at sentencing this court finds the sentence imposed to be appropriate under the circumstances.

THEREFORE, this court DENIES Defendant's Motion to Reconsider Sentence. Further, this court finds that oral argument is not necessary.
