Motion to Extend Time

Jacoby Gregory moves this Court for an order extending the time to file the reply to the State’s return to his petition for a writ of certiorari until Monday, May 12, 2025. This final request for an extension is based on counsel’s other professional obligations and not intended for delay. On May 2, 2025, counsel submitted post-hearing reply briefs in *Stone v. State*, 2018-CP-43-01025 and *Terry v. State*, No. 2022-CP-32-00924, both of which are successive post-conviction relief cases involving eligibility for the death penalty pursuant to *Atkins v. Virginia*, 536 U.S. 304 (2002). This morning, counsel had a juvenile hearing in Greenville County. Petition No. 2024-JU-23-01442, 01443. This afternoon, counsel had a video conference with Mr. Gregory to discuss the contents of the reply.

The reply is substantially complete, and counsel hoped to file today. Counsel will use three-day weekend created by the state holiday to complete the pleading. Counsel is
