Please excuse my untimely response to the Court's September 24, 2013, letter inquiring about the status of the trial transcript in the Atkinson appeal. Please note we sent pre-payment to Ms. Brenda Sigwald, Court Reporter, for the Transcript of Record in the Atkinson case on August 14, 2014. We received an electronic version of the transcript via email on September 17, 2013; however, we are awaiting receipt of an original transcript. I got the September 24th letter today which the Court addressed to Corbin Law Firm at P.O. Box 447. 
