Upon reviewing your notice of appeal filed on March 31, 2025, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and each deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this matter will be dismissed. This is the Court's second request for these corrections:

- The notice of appeal is not accompanied by the order(s) and/or judgment(s) challenged on appeal.
- The proof of service has not been signed as required by Rule 267(b), SCACR.

Furthermore, upon reviewing your second notice of appeal filed on April 11, 2025, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and each deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this matter will be dismissed:

- You must provide proof of filing a copy of your second notice of appeal with the clerk of the lower court.

- The accompanying proof of service for your second notice of appeal is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. Specifically, you must provide proof of service stating that a copy of your second notice of appeal has been served on the respondent.
