

Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Nasirea Grate with the Court of Appeals on April 16, 2025. Counsel appeared for Oral Argument in the case of The State v. Quayshawn Clark before the Court of Appeals on April 10, 2025. Counsel filed the Brief of Petitioner in the case of Andre T. Heatley, Jr. v. The State with the Supreme Court on March 14, 2025. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Denardis Kilgo with the Court of Appeals on March 5, 2025. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. James Brown with the Court of Appeals on March 5, 2025. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Casey Fickling v. The State with the Supreme Court on March 4, 2025.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that his caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

4. On April 30, 2025, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through May 31, 2025.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty (30) day extension. Counsel respectfully requests that the time limits for serving and filing the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.
