MOTION TO WAIVE SUPERSEDEAS BOND

COMES NOW the Appellants, Brittney L. Greene a/k/a Brittney L. Golson, Tremaine Golson a/k/a Tremaine D. Golson, pursuant to Rule 241 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and respectfully moves this Honorable Court to waive the requirement for a supersedeas bond during the pendency of this appeal.

In support of this motion, the Appellant states the following:

1. A final judgment was entered against Appellants on May 8, 2025 in the Richland County Court of Common Pleas.
2. A Notice of Appeal was timely filed on March 3, 2025, initiating the appellate process.
3. Appellant seeks a stay of enforcement of the judgment pending appeal but is financially unable to post the supersedeas bond required under Rule 241(b).
4. Appellant is an individual of limited means, not a corporation or business entity.

Requiring the full amount of the bond as calculated based on commercial or institutional standards would impose an undue and unconstitutional burden, effectively denying meaningful access to appeal.

5. Appellant is acting in good faith and not seeking delay. The appeal raises substantial issues, and enforcement of the judgment before resolution would cause irreparable Harm.

6. Appellant is willing to provide alternative security if the Court deems it appropriate and equitable.

7. Appellant may also seek relief under Rule 225, SCACR, as necessary, to preserve jurisdiction or prevent injustice.



WHEREFORE, Appellant respectfully prays that the Court issue an order:
