ORDER

Appellant has appealed an Administrative Law Court order dismissing her appeal of a decision by the South Carolina Department of Employment and Workforce. On March 24, 2025, Appellant moved to proceed *in forma pauperis*. The right to proceed *in forma pauperis* must rest upon a statute or a fundamental constitutional right. *See Ex parte Martin*, 321 S.C. 533, 471 S.E.2d 134 (1995). Appellant has the burden of showing she is entitled to this relief, but she has not done so. Therefore, Appellant's motion is denied. The filing fee must be paid within fifteen days of the date of this order. Failure to provide the filing fee will result in dismissal of the appeal.
