Dear Ms. Howard:

Pursuant to Rule 208(b)(7) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, Appellant Asbestos Corporation Limited (“ACL”) writes to notify this Court of a further ruling of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of New York (the “Bankruptcy Court”) that is pertinent to this appeal.

On May 20, 2025, the Bankruptcy Court entered an Order Granting Provisional Relief (the “Provisional Relief Order,” attached hereto as Exhibit A) that extends the stay of all litigation against ACL and certain other Stay Parties under the Bankruptcy Court’s Temporary Restraining Order (“TRO”) until the Bankruptcy Court rules on ACL’s petition for recognition of ACL’s Canadian insolvency proceedings under chapter 15 of the U.S. Bankruptcy Code. The Bankruptcy Court has scheduled a hearing on ACL’s petition for recognition for June 30, 2025. See Exhibit B (ACL’s Notice of Adjournment and Rescheduling of Recognition Hearing).

For the reasons stated in ACL’s May 16, 2025 response to this Court’s May 8, 2025 letter, ACL respectfully submits that the Provisional Relief Order, like the TRO, stays further proceedings in this appeal.
