Respondent The Regional Medical Center (“Regional Medical Center”) respectfully submits this reply to Appellant’s opposition to Regional Medical Center’s first request for an extension of time to file Respondent’s Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be included in the Record on Appeal in Appellate Case No. 2025-000108.

Pro Se Appellant’s letter opposing Respondent’s first request for an extension of time grossly mischaracterizes the facts, and Regional Medical Center firmly objects to Appellant’s assertion that Regional Medical Center utilized delay tactics in the underlying trial court matter and somehow seeks to do the same here. It is unclear how Regional Medical Center’s requested extension prejudices the pro se Appellant, particularly when it was the pro se Appellant’s own failure to comply with the Rules that resulted in multiple delays in the initiation of this appeal.

Respondent acted in good faith and in compliance with the Rules of Civil Procedure in the lower court and does the same here. Respondent’s request for a thirty-day extension is reasonable, it is made in good faith, and it is made in accordance with the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. It is not being requested for purposes of unnecessary delay or to prejudice the Appellant. Accordingly, Respondent respectfully requests that the Court grant the requested thirty-day extension, up to and including June 20, 2025.
